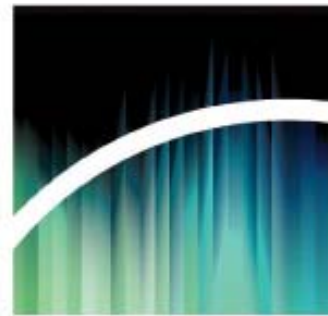
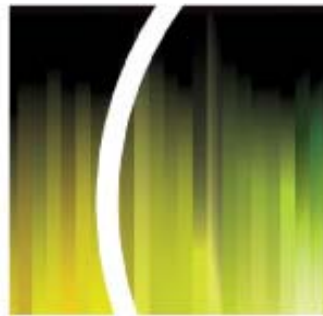
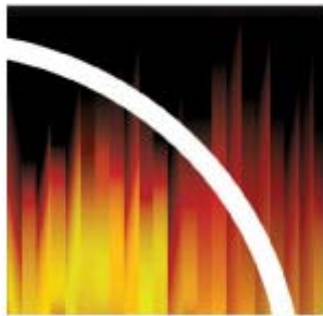

| <b>Prophecy</b>          | The ability to receive and communicate a direct message from God. Acts 18:9; Acts 21:9-11; Romans 12:6; 1 Cor. 12:10, 28; 1 Cor. 14.   |
| <b>Evangelist</b>        | The ability to share the gospel with non-believers in such a way that they respond by becoming followers of Christ and responsible members of his church. Acts 8:5-13; Acts 8:26-39; Acts 14:21; Eph. 4:11-14; 2 Tim. 4:5.   |
| <b>Teaching</b>          | The ability to master and communicate truth in such a manner that others will learn. Matt. 5-7; Acts 18:24-28; Romans 12:7; 1 Cor. 12:28.  |
| <b>Word of Wisdom</b>    | The ability to know the mind of the Spirit in a situation and to communicate clearly the insight necessary to meet the need of the situation. John 8:7; 1 Cor. 2:1-13; Acts 6:3, 10; James 1:5; 2 Pet. 3:15, 16.   |
| <b>Word of Knowledge</b> | The ability to receive divinely revealed information that could not be known by natural processes. 2 Kings 6:9-12; Matt. 17:27; Acts 10:17-23; 2 Cor. 11:6; Col. 2:2, 3.   |
| <b>Exhortation</b>       | The ability to motivate people to action, encourage them or comfort them. Acts 11:23; Acts 14:22; Romans 15:30; 1 Tim. 4:13; Hebrews 10:25.  |
| <b>Pastor/Teacher</b>    | The ability to assume responsibility for the spiritual care of a group of God's people. Acts 20:28, 29; Eph. 4:11-14; 1 Tim. 3:1-7; 1 Peter 5:1-3.   |
| <b>Leadership</b>        | The ability to envision God's desired future, communicate the vision to others, and motivate them to work together to achieve it. Luke 9:51; Acts 7:10; Romans 12:8; 1 Tim. 5:17; Hebrews 13:17.   |
| <b>Administration</b>    | The ability to devise, manage, and execute plans to achieve goals and purpose. Luke 14:28-30; Acts 6:1-7; Acts 27:11; 1 Cor. 12:28; Titus 1:5.   |
| <b>Serving</b>           | The ability to invest time and energy unselfishly in performing tasks for God's work, often to assist other gifted individuals by freeing them to dedicate all their time to their primary ministry. Mark 15:40, 41; Luke 8:2, 3; Acts 9:36; Romans 16:1, 2; 1 Cor. 12:28. |
| <b>Hospitality</b>       | The ability to reach out in warmth and love to make people welcome and care for their needs, particularly food and lodging. Acts 16:14, 15; Romans 12:9-13; Romans 16:23; Hebrews 13:1, 2; 1 Peter 4:9.  |
| <b>Giving</b>            | The ability to earn money and give it cheerfully and willingly to meet the needs of God's work. Matt. 12:41-44; Romans 12:8; 2 Cor. 8:1-7; 2 Cor. 9:2-8.   |
| <b>Mercy</b>             | The ability to empathize with those in need and to demonstrate caring by appropriate actions. Mark 9:41; Acts 9:36; Acts 16:33, 34; Romans 12:8.   |
| <b>Faith</b>             | The ability to see God's will for the future and to trust Him to bring it to pass. John 11:43; Acts 21:9-14; 1 Cor. 12:9; Hebrews 11.  |
| <b>Discernment</b>       | The ability to perceive the motivating spirit behind certain words or acts. Matt. 16:23; Acts 5:1-11; Acts 16:16-18; 1 Cor. 14:29; 1 John 4:1-6.   |
